## Street Wise First Aid

### Duration

#### 2-3 hours

The course aims to teach students basic aspects of dealing with emergencies, with an emphasis on those occurring in the street with a particular emphasis on Knife wounds and multiple casualty scenarios.

Handling 'life threatening' situations is covered as well as recognising and responding to some of the more common injuries that may be encountered on the street.

### Objectives

On completion of the course, delegates will be able to recognise and deal with:

- Managing an Emergency situation
- Administer First Aid to an unconscious casualty (including seizures)
- Administer CPR
- Management of a wounded & bleeding casualty
- Administer First aid to a casualty suffering from shock
- Provide appropriate First aid for injuries (including broken limbs, multiple injuries etc).
- Head Injuries
